



Frequently Asked Parent Questions

What are the eligibility requirements?

To qualify, students must:

- be between the ages of 5-22 (K-12 grade level)
- Have an IEP, ISP, or CSEP
- Meet the income qualifications
- Be a resident of Indiana

Can families use other methods of payment?

If a student has a remaining balance to a provider after all ESA funds have been used, the balance may be paid through another payment method. Families may also choose to pay tuition and fees by other means and use ESA for other qualified expenses. Families are responsible for any leftover balance after ESA funds are used.

How does invoicing work?

After services have been provided, the service provider will send an invoice. This invoice will be uploaded by the family into ClassWallet for review by an ESA account specialist for processing. Providers can expect to be paid within 7 business days of invoice submission.

What documentation is required?

Documentation required includes age documentation like a birth certificate, disability documentation like an IEP, income documentation such as a tax return, and residency documentation like a utility bill.

What is ClassWallet?

Upon approval, you will be sent a link to register for a ClassWallet account. ClassWallet is our financial management platform where ESA students will receive their scholarship funds and pay for services from approved providers. Funds will be deposited into your ClassWallet account in 4 disbursements throughout the program year.
